**SINGLELIFECAMP SALUTES SMART SINGLES IN SAN FRANCISCO**

**BarCamp Style Event to explore Interests and Needs of Bay Area Solos**

SAN FRANCISCO, CA — June 21, 2009 — What does it mean to be single, is the question in the hearts and minds of more and more Americans these days. Limited by space to 200 people, SingleLifeCamp tickets are \$30, which include a Champagne Brunch, panel discussions with authors and experts such as Simon Tisminezky, CEO of SpeedDate.com and breakout sessions on topics such as: Social Media Gets You A Social Life, Sin City – The Single Income Lifestyle, Working Solo in Business, and Single Parenting Diaries: Dating with diapers. The day ends with a Fantasy Cake Reception, where wedding cake bakeries will present creations that best represent the sweet life of the sexy single.
